

D181 DHARMA & BOB



On 12 October 1999 D appeared unbilled in a third season episode ("Play Lady Play") of award-winning ABC sitcom *Dharma & Greg*. His participation was brokered by Eddie Gorodetsky, then one of the show's staff writers. (Gorodetsky, a friend of Bob's, subsequently played Bacchus, a minor character with one line of dialogue, in *Masked & Anonymous*, was credited with "special thanks" in *No Direction Home*, wrote the middle third of the *BS7* booklet and is now part of the *Theme Time Radio Hour* production team - all in all, quite impressive D credentials.) *D&G* creator Chuck Lorre said that, after receiving the initial approach, Bob asked his manager to acquire some tapes of the show and, about a month later, sent word that he was willing to do it. Though on set for an hour, D's ultimate screen-time was brief - just three and a half minutes, in which we see him smile, deliver his lines (by the look of it, mostly ad-libbed), play some guitar (pic below) but not, sadly, sing.
